## REGISTRATION

The registration fee is \$300 per participant. For families with more than one child participating in the program, the fee for the additional participants is \$200/child. NOTE: Discounted fee for additional participants in one family is not available online. (Must be paid by check or by contacting the box office.)

The registration fee must be received by the 2020 auditions on May 16. This fee, this signed participant guidelines form and a signed actor's agreement form for each child must be received by June 15, 2020. ### **SCHOLARSHIPS:**

The registration fee may be waived in cases of financial hardship. Generally participants will be considered for a scholarship if they qualify for the free and reduced price lunch program at school. This information will be kept strictly confidential.

### **POLICIES:**

Participants must attend ALL rehearsals – with a positive, cooperative, enthusiastic attitude. The only exception for excuse is a medical or family emergency. If a participant skips one or more rehearsals, his/her role may be diminished or deleted. Attendance at dress rehearsals and all shows is mandatory. Actors are asked to please wear sneakers or shoes that they can dance in to all rehearsals. (No sandals or flip-flops).

For the Junior program, rehearsals begin at 9:00 a.m. This means that at 9:00 a.m. actors must be ready to work on stage and to behave in a cooperative manner. It is recommended that actors arrive at rehearsal five minutes before starting time to get organized and prepared. On rehearsal days, staff will be present at the theatre no later than 8:30 a.m. **Participants cannot be dropped off prior to 8:30 a.m.** Rehearsals end at 4:00 p.m. For family convenience, participants may be picked up as late as 4:30 p.m. Every day there will be a lunch break and snack breaks. Actors are expected to bring their own lunches and snacks.

### **VOLUNTEERS:**

Parental/Guardian assistance during the rehearsal period and during performances is welcomed. Parents should sign up at rehearsals for available volunteer opportunities. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to assist their children in memorizing lines and lyrics!
